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Clinical Approbation Results of the Wound covering Flamena (vaginal set)

Executors:

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Goal of the research:

To evaluate the impact of the *Wound covering Flamena (vaginal set)* on the processes of genital tract mucous coat epithelialization.

Methods:

Approbation of the *Wound coverings* was conducted from 10/04/2011 till 10/06/2011. 27 women at the age from 17 till 50 years old took part in this research. 11 of them had cervix ectopia after the operative therapy (radiotherapy); 12 women had cervix ectopia without operative therapy; 5 women had the prolapse of the uterus that was accompanied by cervix cancer. Treatment was applied by using one doze of *Wound covering Flamena* daily.

Treatment was applied in period without menstrual cycle by using one doze of *Wound covering Flamena* application on the affected area daily. Curing course was 10 days.

Detailed colposcopy with cervix biopsy was applied to make a diagnosis before treatment. The control colposcopy was done after treatment.

Results:

Treatment by using *Wound covering Flamena* led to genital tract rapid mucosa epithelization healing the cervix ectopia. It helped women even after the operative therapy and cancer twice faster than traditional way of treating. None of the patients noticed the discomfort in using *Wound covering Flamena*.

Conclusion:

Wound covering Wound covering Flamena (vaginal set) can be recommended as an effective, convenient, and safe medicine to accelerate the healing and epithelization of genital tract mucosa, cervix cancer, etc. even after the local surgery.
